

Driver's Education 2023

RULES

1. **Student** must be 15 years old by June 2, 2023. No exceptions. Class begins on June 2nd and ends on June 30th. Classes meet 2 hours per day.
2. **Students** must be passing a total of 8 classes in the previous two semesters.
3. Fees are \$100 (payable to Seneca High School) for 4 weeks in the classroom, plus a \$20 cash permit fee.
4. **Any student** enrolled in the summer Driver's Education course will have their 2023/2024 schedule adjusted during summer school.
5. **On March 23rd**, all summer Driver's Education students will report to the commons at 10:30 to complete the permit application, rules of the road test, and eye test.

Permit Application

The permit application will be completed online. Students should know their address, height, weight, eye color, and hair color to complete the application. Please bring \$20 cash for the State of Illinois permit fee.

Rules of the Road Test

The rules of the road test will also be completed online. Prior to **March 23rd**, all students will be given a state booklet to study. Students should read and study chapters 1-11 and learn all road signs.

Eye Test

After completing the permit application and passing the rules of the road test, students will take their eye test as well. If you wear glasses or contacts, please be sure to bring them on **March 23rd** for the testing.

Sign and Return Permit Application

Once all three items are complete, the student will get a printed copy of their permit application to take home for a parent signature. This form will need to be returned to the school, and once the school has the permit applications and permit fees collected, permit applications can be taken to the DMV thirty days prior to the start of the summer class.

Summer School 2023

RULES

1. **Absence policy** for Speech and World History is 1 ½ days and Driver's Education is 1 day.
2. **Allowances** are NOT made for camps or vacations.
3. **Students** are responsible for their own transportation.
4. **Students** are allowed in class or commons only; stay out of areas where custodians are working.
5. **All school rules and regulations** pertain to student behavior during summer school; and no bare midriffs or half shirts are to be worn.
6. **If the registration numbers exceed maximum class size**, all student registration will be prioritized by date of receipt in the guidance office. If numbers exceed, students will be put on a waiting list and issued a refund.
7. **There will be no refund issued for Summer School.**

Registration Deadline is **March 17th, 2023**. There will be no exceptions. Registration form with payment should be **turned in or received** in the SHS Guidance Office at 307 E. Scott Street, Seneca, Illinois 61360 on or before **March 17th**.
