Why we NEED a GSA:

- 74% of LGBT students were verbally harassed in the past year because of their sexual orientation and 55% because of their gender expression.
- 30% missed at least one day of school in the past month.
- Studies have reported that drop out rates for LGBTQ youth are four times the national average.
- Even more concerning, LGBTQ youth are five times more likely to attempt suicide than their heterosexual peers, with a 20% greater risk for those individuals in unsupportive environments.
- LGBTQ youth in rural communities in particular reported higher rates of suicidal behaviors, substance abuse, sexual debut (girls), and dating violence (boys) than did LGBTQ youth in more urban settings.
