

2020 In-Person Learning
Band and Choir

Band

- I. Student instrument cases will be spread out in the band portion of room 217A for quick, socially distanced setup and teardown
- II. Once students have their instruments, the class will move to an outdoor rehearsal space where students will be socially distanced and allowed to remove their face coverings
- III. All music will be sized to fit in a flip folder to remove the need for music stands
- IV. Time will be split between full group rehearsal and sectional rehearsals
- V. When weather does not allow for outdoor rehearsal, students will be provided written work and extra study time in room 217A
- VI. Mouthpiece sanitizer will be provided by the school
- VII. Grading will be a mix of individual recordings and written assignments that will be submitted in Google Classroom

Choir

- I. Students will split time between the auditorium and an outdoor rehearsal space
 - a. While in the auditorium, students will wear face coverings and will be spread out to account for social distancing
 - b. While outside, students work in groups of four and will wear masks and observe social distancing
- II. In the absence of traditional concert performances, students will spend an increased amount of time focusing on vocal technique, music theory, harmonization, and composition
- III. In the absence of a piano during outdoor rehearsal time, the school will purchase 10 portable Bluetooth speakers to allow students to rehearse with recorded practice tracks
- IV. Grading will be a mix of individual recordings and written assignments that will be submitted in Google Classroom
