Dear Seneca High School Families and Staff,

The purpose of this information release is to inform you that Seneca High School will no longer be sending out by phone, regular notices of COVID positive individuals. However, the district will update its website COVID dashboards regularly. We will send a text message with a link to the website for updated information. Additionally, we are writing to inform you that an individual deemed to have been probable for COVID, in fact, tested positive. The individual has been placed into quarantine since Thursday. Importantly, there were no deemed close contacts needed to quarantine.

The health and safety of Seneca High School students and staff continue to be our highest priority and we continue to follow the guidance of the Illinois State Board of Education and state and local health departments for best practices and procedures to protect everyone's health.

Our mitigating efforts to prevent further spread of the disease at Seneca High School include:

- Ongoing monitoring of students and staff of signs and symptoms of illness and evaluation of illness reports to promptly identify possible outbreaks.
- Conducting a deep clean and disinfection of areas impacted by potential exposure to the COVID-19 virus.
- Continuous cycling of bringing in outside air and pushing out inside air through our HVAC system.

As always, everyone should monitor their health and stay at home if they develop symptoms. Sick persons should contact their health care provider to determine if testing is needed. Anyone who develops severe symptoms should seek medical care immediately. If your child has had close contact with a known case of COVID-19, keep the child at home and notify your primary healthcare provider, Seneca High School, and the county health department.

We are committed to providing your child and our staff with a safe and healthy environment. Thank you for your understanding and ongoing cooperation with our COVID-19 prevention policies and procedures as we work to help protect your children, your families, and our staff and their families.
